

DUCK CALLING CONTESTS

All duck calling contests will be on Saturday, March 3rd, 2018 only.

Contests will begin at 9:00am on Saturday, March 3rd, 2018.

The meat duck contest will be judged on a 90 second standard meat duck routine.

All final round ties will be determined by call offs.

Duck calling contests (in order):

- **Youth duck** – 12 years of age and younger on day of contest. Free entry. This will be a 60 second meat duck routine. Prizes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places. All entrants will receive a free duck call from Sure-Shot Game Calls.
- **Intermediate duck** – 16 years of age and younger. \$5 entry. This will be a 60 second meat duck routine. Prizes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places. All entrants receive a free duck call from Sure-Shot Game Calls.
- **Texas State Open** – All ages can compete. \$50 entry. All contestants MUST be a resident of Texas. Main Street style routine. This event is a World Duck Calling Championship qualifier in Stuttgart, Arkansas. This will be a 90 second routine. 1st place - \$500, 2nd place - \$250, 3rd place - \$100, 4th place - \$50, 5th place - \$50.
- **Team Meat Duck** – All ages can compete. \$50 entry per person. This will be a 90 second meat duck routine. 2 team maximum per contestant. Prizes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places.
- **Open Meat Duck** – All ages can compete. \$50 entry. This will be a 90 second meat duck routine. 1st place - \$1500, 2nd place - \$500, 3rd place - \$250.

Goose calling contests (in order):

- **Hunter Speck** – Open to all ages. \$25 entry. Contestants must not have previously won a speck calling competition anywhere. There is no formal routine in the Hunter Speck contest. The caller should assume field conditions and use the appropriate calling sounds from the time he/she sees far geese until he/she calls the shot. 1st place – shotgun, prizes for 2nd and 3rd places.
- **Team Speck** – Open to all ages. \$50 entry per person. 2 team maximum per contestant. Caller must follow routine as outlined and published by the Winnie Area Chamber of Commerce on MarshFest.com website. Prizes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places.
- **Open Speck** – Open to all ages. \$50 entry. Caller must follow routine as outlined and published by the Winnie Area Chamber of Commerce on MarshFest.com website. 1st place - \$1500, 2nd place - \$500, 3rd place - \$250
- **Team Snow** – Open to all ages. \$50 entry per person. 2 team maximum per contestant. Caller must follow routine as outlined and published by the Winnie Area Chamber of Commerce on MarshFest.com website. Prizes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places.
